What started as a typical booze fueled Saturday night quickly turned tragic with a poor choice. Kevin Brooks and his childhood friend Brandon left a party, intoxicated and driving in excessive speeds. The result - a horrific crash that Kevin did not walk away from and Brendon did not survive.

Today, from his wheelchair, Kevin tells his life changing story to audiences across North America. In the years since he started speaking, Kevin has lost close friends to suicide, gun violence, and an accidental Fentanyl overdose. He has included these stories and messages with his own to deliver a multi-layered, hard-hitting presentation that reaches students like none other.

Kevin's Story has reached over half a million people in well over 1000 high schools and community sponsored events. He has been the keynote speaker at numerous Provincial, State, and National conferences and has appeared in various media programs such as *The Tyra Show* in 2007 and the Reebok *Be More Human Campaign*, which aired during Super Bowl XLIX.
