BASIC RULES FOR TEEN DRIVER
• I will always tell an adult where I am going and when I will return. I understand that I will not be allowed any non-adult passengers until after I have had my license for months. At that point, I may be allowed to have 1 passenger. Any changes to this must be approved in advance by my parent or guardian.
<ul> <li>I will always wear my seatbelt and require anyone in the car with me to also be buckled up.</li> <li>I will obey the speed limits and all traffic laws and signs. I will be responsible for any traffic tickets or parking tickets and any court costs.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>I will avoid all distractions and all behaviors which take my hands off the steering wheel, or my mind or eyes off the road –even for a second!</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>I will avoid driving during heavy rains or high winds unless accompanied by an adult.</li> <li>I will drive only on surface roads in our local area, avoiding large roadways, expressways and interstates until my adult parent or guardian has approved additional roadways for my use.</li> </ul>
Roadway restrictions:
<ul> <li>I will never drive if I am angry, upset or tired.</li> <li>I will never drive unless I am alcohol and drug-free, and I will never allow alcohol or illegal drugs in the car. I will not drive if I am taking prescription or over-the-counter medication that could impair my driving</li> <li>I will never drive anyone else's car unless I have the adult car owner's permission.</li> </ul>
