





 <p>TRUCKS MAKE WIDE TURNS GIVE TRUCKS EXTRA SPACE</p> <p>Avoid blind spots and allow for proper spacing between big trucks. Focus on driving.</p> <p>FDOT ZERO SAFER DRIVING</p>	<p>🚚 Always be aware of your surroundings when driving near commercial motor vehicles. Give big trucks plenty of room to merge and change lanes, and avoid cutting in front of them abruptly. 	<p>👁️ According to the National Safety Council, over half of distracted walking injuries occur in our own homes, proving that we need to stay aware of our surroundings whether indoors and out.</p> <p>Stay alert!
